



Olaf Katzer studied music and psychology in Munich, Weimar and Dresden. During his studies he founded the Ensemble AuditivVokal Dresden in 2007.

Over 100 world premieres and first performances, guest performances at numerous festivals and radio recordings document his commitment to "contemporary" vocal music. Concert tours in almost all European countries, as well as Taiwan, China, the USA and South America. In transdisciplinary exchange with singers, instrumentalists, dancers, composers, painters, directors and scientists, he develops contemporary ensemble art for the 21st century in sustainable and unconventional programs.

Invitations to conduct orchestras such as the RIAS Kammerchor, the SWR Vocalensemble Stuttgart, the MDR Rundfunkchor and the Dresdner Kammerchor. Lecturer for choral conducting at Hochschule für Musik Dresden since 2011, since 2015/16 as a substitute professor for choral conducting. In 2019 Olaf Katzer received the advancement award of the state capital Dresden and in 2020 the Arras award.
